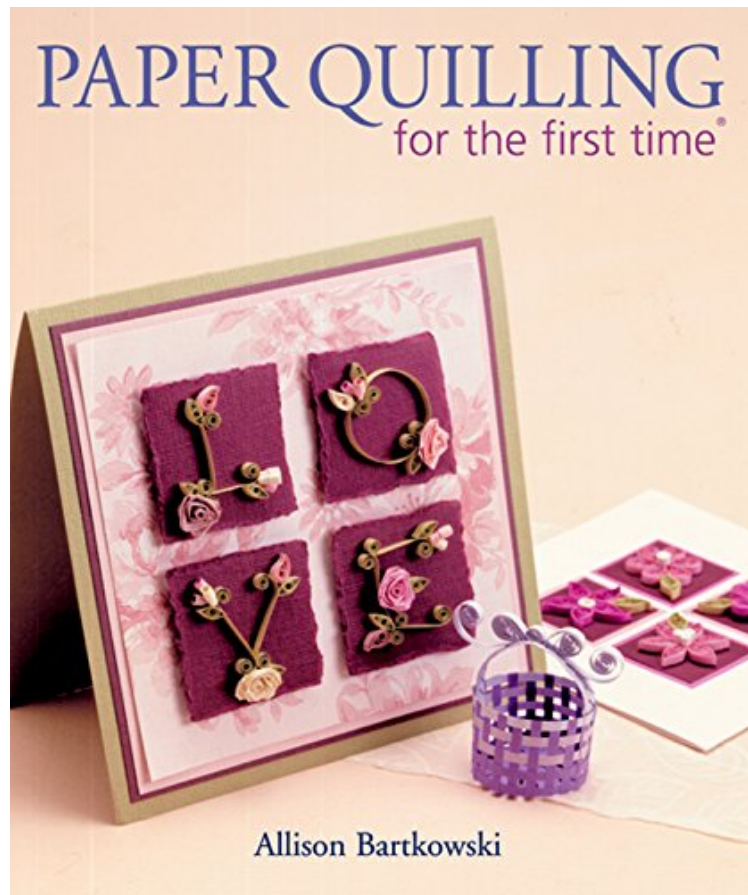

The photography is excellent and in a format large enough to see detail. The typeset is a large font and easy to read. As far as projects, some are cute and some are, in my opinion, not what I would use. All are basic beginner projects. If you want instructions in quilled card-making

then you might want to pass on this one. Focuses on classic paper quilling: a form of filigree that's perfect for scrap booking, as well as card and ornament making. Using a friendly question and answer format and dozens of close-up step-by-step photographs, this title explains how to roll coils, make basic shapes and create off-centred circles, scrolls, roses, and loops.

From Booklist Colored paper might be the artistic mainstay of elementary-school kids--but, thanks to Bartkowski's easy-to-understand instructions, adults could soon adopt the medium, too. Originating in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries as a religious decoration, quilling today is gaining a wider audience as it showcases its versatility as a three-dimensional stand-alone and enhancer in media such as scrapbooking and greeting cards. Here, the first-time author uses a question-and-answer format, introducing the needed tools and supplies at the outset, then following the basics with techniques (including combing, crimping, and boondoggling, or a form of braiding), and patterns. Among the illustrated choices are a minirose gift tag, scrolled border frames for all kinds of mementos, and Christmas ornaments.
