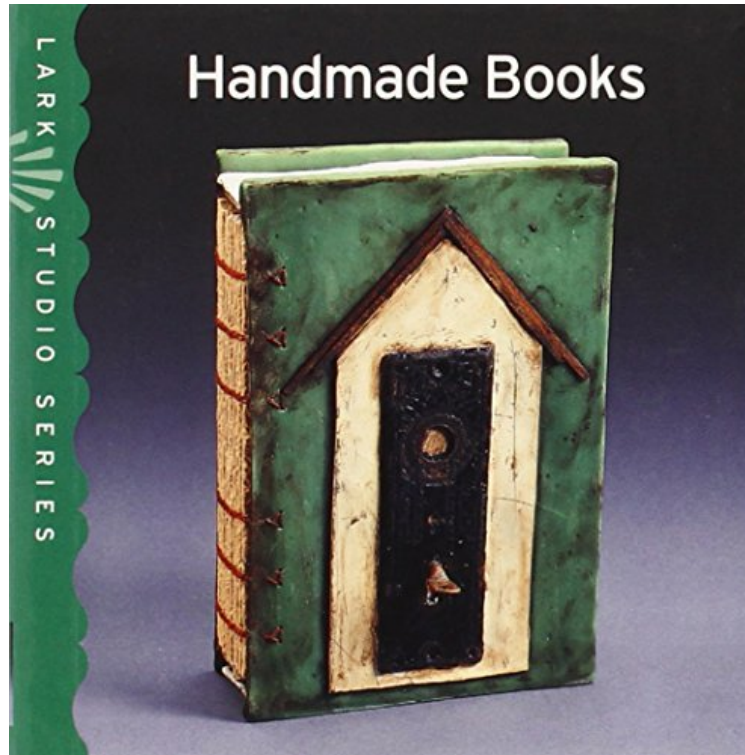

BorlozI ordered this book not knowing that all of the photos are already published in another book, 500 Handmade Books. I discovered this from reading the copyright page of this book, and I already owned 500 Handmade Books. It would be nice if this information is provided in the book description above.It is interesting to see which photos were selected from the larger volume, and if you need to reduce the shelf space to make room for other new (or used) books, you could sell 500 Handmade Books and buy this smaller book. But, if I were you, I would recommend that you look at this smaller book first before you order it to decide whether you wish to keep the unabbreviated or the smaller version.If you have not yet bought the big one, you might want to buy the smaller one before you decided to get the unabbreviated and bigger version. I would rather see

that only the unabbreviated one be in print as it would not make it easier for most handmade book lovers to decide which version they want to keep. Not only that, the new smaller book gave a false impression that all of the handmade books inside are new. In summary, I wish that it could be mentioned upfront in the book description that none of the handmade books are new, but "recycled" from the previously published book, *500 Handmade Books*. I also wish that this has never happened as I am not a big fan of "republished" books.
