Only two bears, but lots of clothesBy FrostyThis book contains 2 bears, and various outfits.The knit bear has a very flat disc shaped head and the crocheted bear an extremely long muzzle. The knit bear is about twice the size of the crocheted bear, who is not made with yarn. I think the shape of the heads could be improved. The ideal shape lies between these two choices.Each section has these 2 bears dressed in different clothes, you can make. The clothes are clever.I wish the directions were for bears that had shapes I liked, and that the two methods, produced bears of the same size. I was not moved to grab the crochet hook next to me and start a bear, so I can't comment on how accurately the directions are written.

Small in size but big in character, the teddy bear gets the craft treatment with these 40 unique patterns to knit crochet. Using material from two books in the Twenty to Make series - Crocheted Bears Knitted Bears - this guide provides

two basic bear patterns and 40 different outfits.
