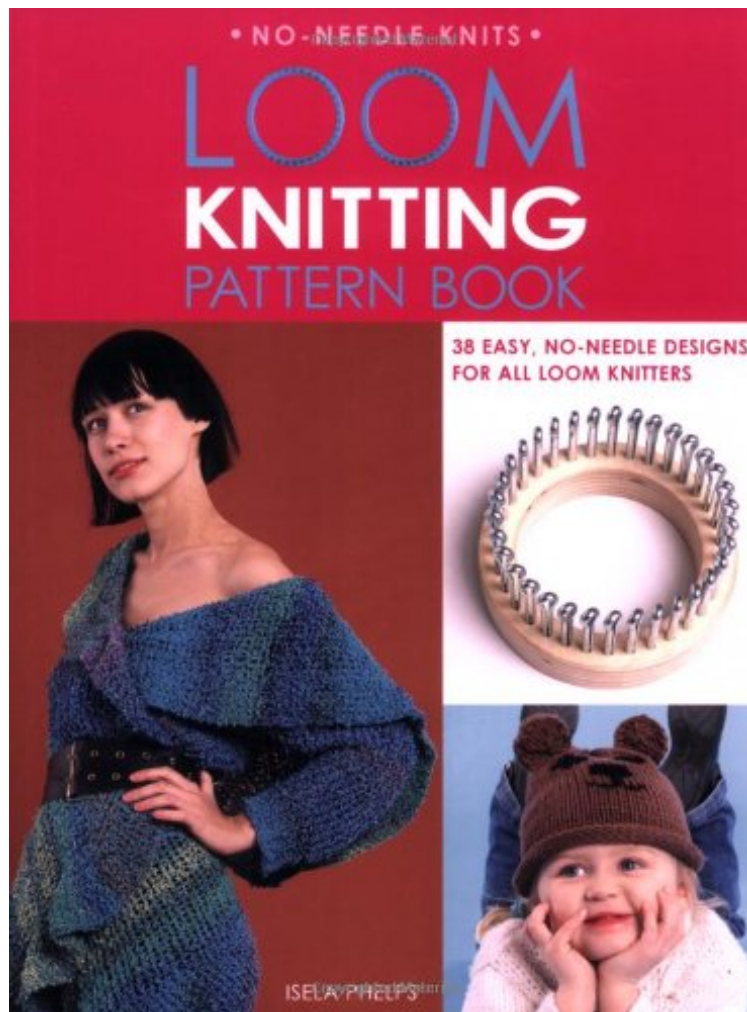

It has some nice clothing patterns for children and adults that I can't wait to try. The one problem I have with this book, and other loom knitting books, is the looms used in the pattern might not be a loom you have or are capable of getting due to money or the company that made the loom being out of business (DA Looms). For example, if the only loom you have is a Knifty Knitter, this book will frustrate you since many patterns call for a finer gauge loom with more pegs than Knifty Knitters have. Fortunately, there are other companies that are making smaller gauge looms like Authentic Knitting Board and Martha Stewart loom, but of course that requires you to spend money on those looms. Bottom line, if you are really into loom knitting and understand it's requirements, this book is for you. If you have never loom knit before, I would suggest Isela Phelps' Loom Knit Primer or I can't believe I'm loom knitting by Kathy Norris as good starting points.3 of 3 people found the following review helpful.
