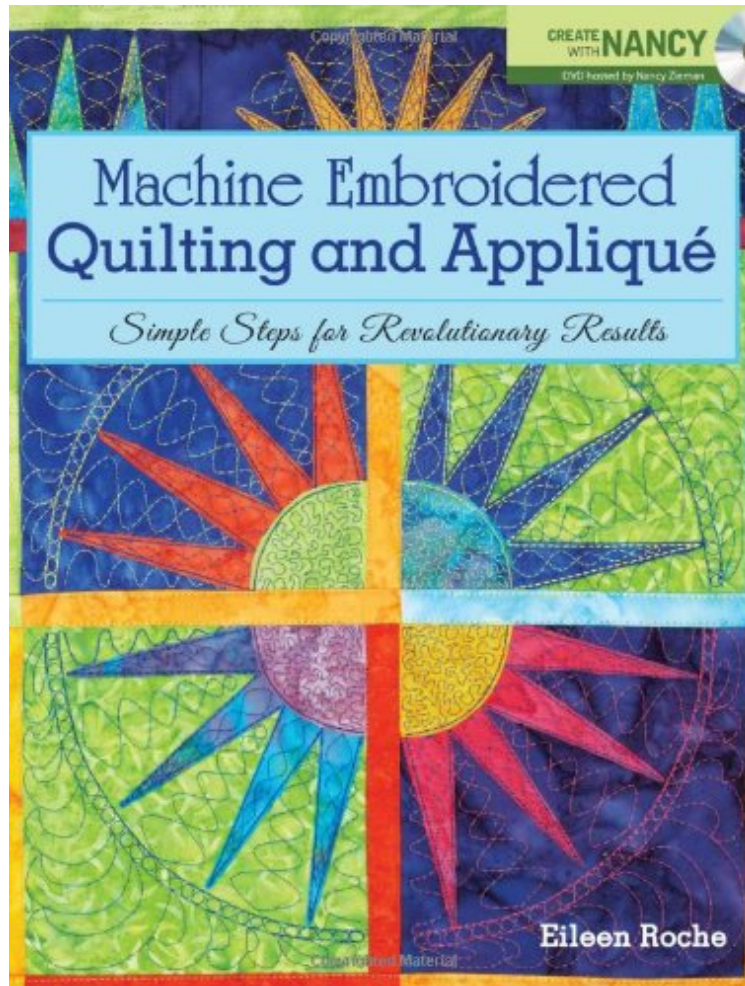

I am now working on Lady Liberty Quilt. There are many errors in the poorly written and difficult to read instructions. From trimming pieces to the finished size rather than unfinished size, neglecting to say the design on one of the spike borders on each side has to be "flipped" so the spikes and mid-border meet in the center as pictured in the book, and referring to the horizontal borders as vertical and vice versa has made this project more difficult than it needs to be.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. but
