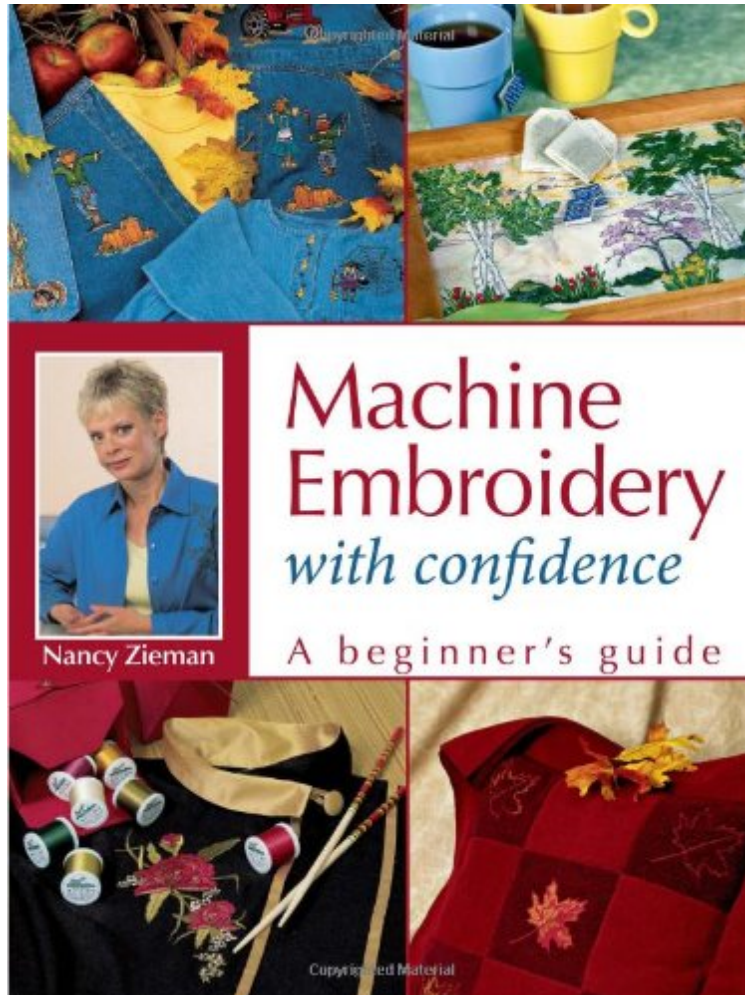

For instance, the author talks about the need for the right stabilizer/fabric/design match, but gives no real information on how to determine what that is.
