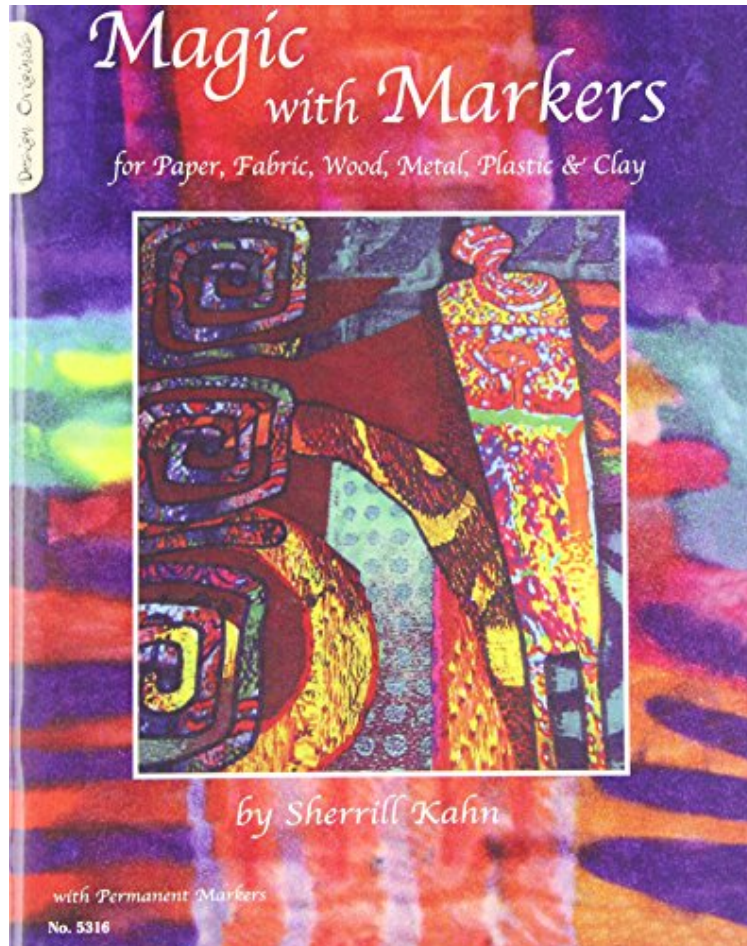

I ordered this book to use as support for a class I gave on decorating fabric with markers and alcohol. The class went well and the students enjoyed the project and I've no doubt the book was inspiring to them; some wrote down the title and may follow up with a purchase themselves. I wish the book had more detailed information about longevity - how will this method of coloring fabrics hold up over repeated washing, wear and exposure to light? Is the ink going to discolor or damage the fabric over time?... She does refer to heat setting fabric at one point but with many of the projects suggested, there is no reference to whether to heat

set or not nor how well a project will fare without this step. I also wonder about longevity for some processes such as drawing on plastic or clay; a friend of mine used Magic Markers to create an outdoor mural and it faded after one season. There are a few 'project' suggestions but little step-by-step methodology in the book. Overall, it felt like it was a 'hurried' production unlike Sherrill Kahn's other books on embellishments which are very good. It did help support the class though and the price of the book was not out of line for the amount of information it provided.
