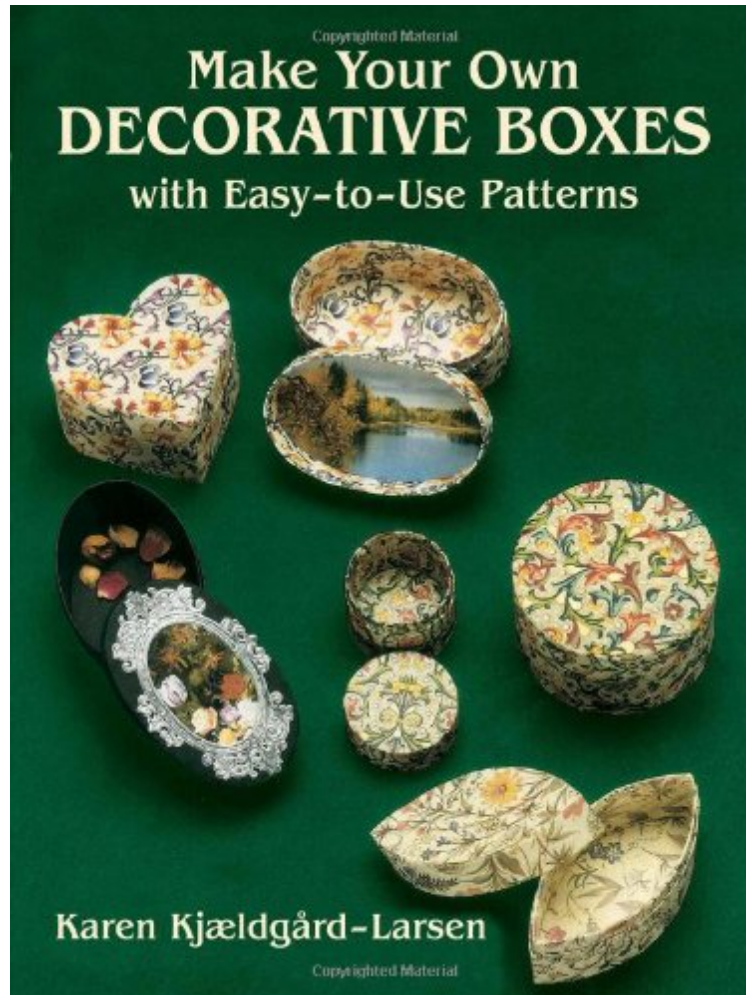

Instructions are pretty clear and I could understand everything. All the gift boxes that are square or rectangle are not difficult to make. You need to enlarge the drawings to make them bigger and make sure everything fits well with the enlargement. I did all the square and rectangle boxes, there are like 4 or 5 different types and I thought they looked nice, while you are putting them together, you learn

some tricks and you find the best way for you to make them. The second part of the book tries to teach you how to do oval boxes, heart-shaped boxes, round boxes, all the shapes you see in the front cover and I only tried doing one and it was so complicated I gave up. It is really difficult. If you are looking to make only the square boxes, you will find the instructions are clear and it is not so complicated but trying to do the other shapes was impossible for me, very time consuming and a lot of work for a tiny little box.
