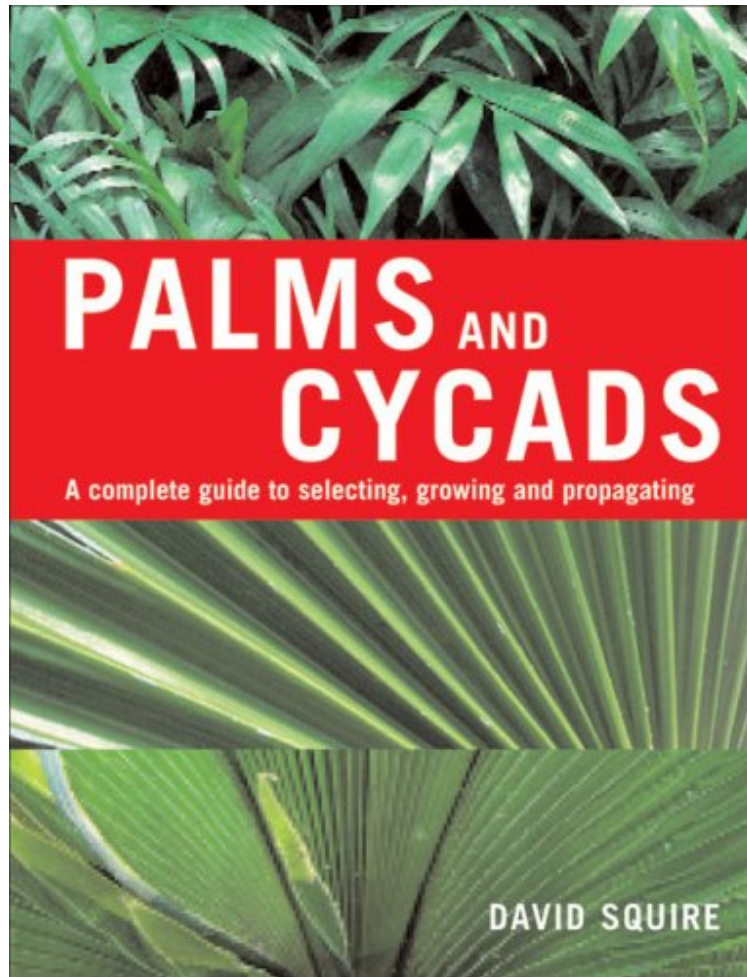

you belong to the lucky ones living in a warm climate and want to learn basics about palm and cycas culture - well, this is your book! Excellent illustrations and good, compact information. If you need in-depth information on palms or if you live in a zone 7 or 8 climate, this book may not be complete enough for you, because many frost hardy palms have been omitted. In this so called "Complete" guide no information is given about winter protection and how to cultivate palms with borderline hardiness in your garden.

Providing comprehensive information on care and cultivation, as well as sound advice on determining perfect plant location, this reference profiles 99 palm and 17 cycad species. Plantlovers looking to add a tropical accent to the garden or wanting to invest in a low-maintenance houseplant will find plenty of guidance in this alphabetical guide to plants suited to a variety of climates and soil types. A special section also provides help with matching palm species to indoor and outdoor settings and features further brief entries on 85 palms and 18 cycad species, making it an extremely useful source book for gardeners, interiorscapers, and landscapers all over the world.
